## Future Street Work Planned

Miller & Associates, working as the Village Engineer, has put together the 1 and 6 year street plan. This plan is a list of future street projects we have designated for repair or replacement.

Projects on the plan include 4 blocks of Elm Street (Main St.) which would include a new water main, and 4 blocks of new asphalt from Maud St. to Ella St. Estimated cost is \$700,000

Other plans are to asphalt Pine St. from the highway to Maud St. Estimated cost is \$170,000, as well as the corner of Ella and Pine.

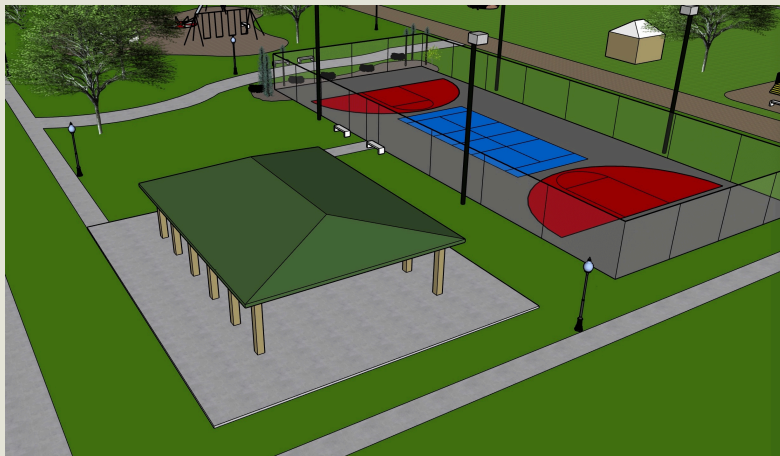


## Blackbird Park Improvements

The Park Committee members are busy finalizing plans for a fund raiser called FESTIVAL OF TABLES. The banquet will be held February 11. The concept is to buy a chair or table and decorate it. More information will follow.

The banquet is only one of several methods to raise funds for the next project for the park. Pictured below, is a 30 foot by 40 foot pavilion that will be built on the old basketball court. It will have a metal roof and ceiling, as well as posts. The project is estimated to cost around \$20,000.

Most of the sidewalks have been installed. There is approximately a ¼ mile of concrete. The final sidewalk will be poured south of the tennis court, connecting the entire complex.



# Village Meeting Minutes

- Ongoing discussions are taking place in regards to the repairs that will take place at the sewer lagoon.
- Nuisance properties have been designated and citations are being given out to property owners. If your property is “unsightly” or offense to the senses, your property will be deemed a nuisance.
- The truck route laws have been adopted and are being enforced. If you drive a truck and are parking at your house, or on any street other than the designated truck routes, you will be cited for disobeying the truck route laws.
- Conditional use permits **MUST** be issued if you want farm animals in town. It is against the law to have these animals without a permit. If you are bringing these animals into town without this permit, you will be cited for breaking this law. Remove these animals at once!
